TEACHER'S GUIDE: WHAT'S YOUR TAKE

Common Core Standards

i. Write arguments to support claims in an analysis of substantive topics or texts, using valid reasoning and relevant and sufficient evidence.

Teaching Suggestions:

i. Scaffolding:

- 1. Select a recent podcast that contains several stories that students might have opinions about.
- 2. After listening, brainstorm possible topics with the whole class.
- 3. For students who are struggling, offer specific prompts, such as "Do you agree or disagree that...?" "Did you think X was a good idea?"

ii. Enrichment:

- 1. Lead a debate on one or more of the topics that came up in the news.
- 2. Have students choose one news story to research more deeply, then write a persuasive essay to convince others of their opinion.
